The “Centre of Excellence for ICT in East Africa” (**CENIT@EA**), a project of the East African Community (**EAC**) in cooperation with the **German Government**, invites you to a unique chance of acquiring digital skills and certificates from **state of the art eMobilis training curricula in Android Mobile Applications**. CENIT@EA is a regional innovation hub providing skills for the digital transformation of East Africa. It is implemented by the Inter-University Council for East Africa (IUCEA) together with an East African-German academic consortium, GIZ and DAAD.

These trainings are offered **free of charge** as **interactive online trainings** for **young job seeking aspiring tech enthusiasts in the EAC with prior knowledge in ICT**. Participants must be unemployed and job seeking university graduates who can use this opportunity to increase their chances of employment.

Trainings will be provided **for a maximum of 25 participants over 20 days (09:00 – 13:00) in each EAC Partner State**.
