The teaching consists of min. **8 hours** of frontal lessons during a minimum period of mobility of 5 days and will be held in English. Maximum number of days available are 14, including 2 days of travel. Travel and individual support will be entirely covered by the project, based on the grant conditions as stated in the Inter-institutional agreement signed.
