Announcement of Full Scholarships under the Centre for Research, Agricultural Advancement, Teaching Excellence and Sustainability in Food and Nutritional Security (CREATES) for 2021/2022 Academic Year

The Nelson Mandela African Institution of Science and Technology (NM-AIST) in Arusha, Tanzania, through the Centre for Research, Agricultural Advancement, Teaching Excellence and Sustainability in Food and Nutritional Security (CREATES), is looking for six (6) candidates, three (3) to pursue Masters and three (3) to pursue PhD in Human Nutrition and Dietetics at NM-AIST. This is a full scholarship as per NM-AIST fee structure. Priority research areas for this call include: maternal, infant and child nutrition innovations; healthcare nutrition (nutritional management of disease/condition/medical nutrition, consumer care and therapeutic nutrition), personalized nutrition; and community nutrition. These are full scholarships as per the NM-AIST fees structure.

Eligibility criteria

The applicants will be required to submit the following:

- 1) One page of motivation letter.
- 2) Certified copies of academic transcripts and certificates in any of the following fields: human nutrition, food science, community nutrition, dietetics, home economics and other relevant fields.
- 3) NM-AIST student admission letter. Those who don't have admission letters can apply it through the following link **not later than 15th December 2021**: <https://oas.nm-aist.ac.tz:8443/noas/>.
- 4) Research concept note focusing on the mentioned priority research areas
- 5) Evidence of excellent command and knowledge of computer application programs such as Word, excel, power point, and MS Project.
- 6) A maximum of 2-page of Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- 7) Evidence of at least one (1) peer reviewed published or accepted paper as a 1st Author in the related field (Human Nutrition and Dietetics or related fields) for PhD candidates.
- 8) Evidence of at least one (1) peer reviewed publication or accepted paper in the focus field or related field will be an added advantage for a Masters Candidates.

Other Instructions

1. Incomplete documents or failure to follow instructions will automatically lead to disqualification.
2. Only successful candidates will be informed for further instructions on reporting time to commence studies at NM-AIST.
